

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION

A special meeting of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission was held pursuant to written notice to all members at the domicile of the Commission on November 30, 1962 at 7:00 o'clock P.M. The meeting was called to order by the President who presided.

The purpose of this meeting was to go over the permit of the Cal-Ky Pipe Line Company.

The President reported that the damming of the Fourchon was about 65% completed.

After discussion, upon motion duly made by Daize Cheramie, seconded by Earl Angelle and unanimously carried, it was,

RESOLVED: <sup>58</sup> that the Greater Lafourche Port Commission issue a permit to the Cal-Ky Pipe Line Company in accordance with specifications, but subject to full compliance by Cal-Ky Pipe Line Company with all provisions contained in its permits received from the Louisiana Department of Public Work, and the U.S. Corps of Engineer.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
