

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION  
NOVEMBER 14, 1963

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission, of the State of Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place, the Office of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, Galliano, Louisiana, on Thursday, November 14, 1963, at 10:00 A.M., pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner required by law.

There were present: Senator A.O. Rappelet, Felton Galiano, Jessie Savoie, Daize Cheramie, Euzebe Chouest and Dr. J.A. Gravois.

There were absent: Jessie Guidry, Earl Angelle and Guilmo Pitre.


The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Senator A.O. Rappelet, President, who announced the purposes of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the Commission was ready for the transaction of business.


The minutes of the previous meeting were then read. On motion duly made by Euzebe Chouest, seconded by Daize Cheramie, and unanimously carried it was moved that the minutes be adopted as read.

Sealed bids for the deepening and widening of Belle Pass and Bayou Lafourche were then received and opened, bids being received from the following, and opened in the order listed: Louisiana Paving Company, Inc. Ruston, Louisiana; Circle, Inc., Harvey, Louisiana; Jahncke Service, Inc., New Orleans, Louisiana; Standard Dredging Corporation, New Orleans, Louisiana; and Williams-McWilliams Industries, Inc., New Orleans, Louisiana. It was moved by Felton Galiano, seconded by Euzebe Chouest and duly passed that the five bids be taken under advisement to be tabulated by the firm of Dawson, Gilbert & Pilcher, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, such tabulation report to be forwarded to the Board of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission within thirty (30) days. It was further resolved that the formal bids be inserted in the minute book.

There being no further business to come before the board, upon motion by Euzebe Chouest seconded by Jessie Guidry and unanimously carried the meeting was adjourned.
