

FEBRUARY 18, 1966

The Greater Lafouche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in special session at its regular meeting place, the office of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, Galliano, Louisiana, on Friday, February 18, 1966 at 10:00 A.M. pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner required by law.

There were present: Hon. A. O. Rappelet, Felton Galliano, Euzebe Chouest, Earl Angelle, Dr. J. A. Gravois, Daize Cheramie and Dudley Bernard.

There were absent: Jessie Guidry, and Minor Cheramie.

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Hon. A. O. Rappelet, President, who announced the purpose of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the commission was ready for the transaction of business.

Upon motion by Euzebe Chouest, seconded by Earl Angelle and duly passed, it was moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted as read.

The President then presented and welcomed guests.

Bids were then opened in accordance with previous advertisement and such bids are attached hereto as addendum # 1, Bid received from Guidry Motors of Galliano, Inc.; in the amount of \$2326.49; addendum # 2, bid received from Cliff Motor Co., Inc. in the amount of 2700.00; addendum # 3, bid received from Cliff Motor Co., Inc. in the amount of \$1950.00; and addendum # 4 bid received from Cliff Motor Co., Inc. in the amount of \$2550.00. Upon motion of Earl Angelle, seconded by Daize Cheramie and unanimously carried, that the bid of Guidry Motors of Galliano, Inc. be accepted for the purchase of a new 1966 Chrysler Station Wagon.

Upon Motion by Dr. J. A. Gravois, seconded by Euzebe Chouest and Dudley Bernard that the Greater Lafourche Port Commission secure the services of J. Wayne Plaisance, EE, to handle the preparation of plans and specifications for bids for the retentions dykes as outlined in the board meeting of January 21, 1966. This motion was unanimously carried;

Upon motion by Daize Cheramie, seconded by Felton Galliano, and unanimously carried, it was moved that the following be advertised in the legal journal and for three consecutive issues:

#### NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids are to be received by the Greater Lafourche Port Commission in the meeting room of the Port Commission Building, Galliano, Louisiana, until 10:30 A.M. April 18, 1966 for the construction of approximately 50,000' (feet) of retaining levees for the Golden Meadow - Leeville Sweepout Project, at which time they will be publicly opened. Sealed proposalss shall be marked: "Retainer Levees-Golden Meadow-Leeville.

The character of the bid shall be unit price per linear foot.

The Contractor agrees to furnish the Greater Lafourche Port Commission with a 5% bid bond, cashier's check or approval equal.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a 100% performance security or bond upon signing the contract.

Bidders shall state the number of consecutive working days to complete the project including the day the work order is issued.

Pay Payments shall be made in thirty day installments according to estimates of work completed made by the engineer.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the Greater Lafourche Port Commission reserving the right to reject any and all bids.

J. Wayne Plaisance, Civil Engineer, will be the authorized representative of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission and the construction and progress of the project will be subject to his inspections.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from the office of J. Wayne Plaisance, P. O. Box 755, Golden Meadow, Louisiana for \$25.00 per set with no refund, or may be examined at the Port Commission Office in Galliano, Louisiana.

It was then moved by Daize Cheramie, seconded by Euzebe Chouest and unanimously carried that the meeting be adjourned.
