

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION

JUNE 23, 1970

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in regular session at its regular meeting place, the office of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, Galliano, Louisiana, on Tuesday, June 23, 1970, at 7:00 P.M. pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner required by law.

There were present: A. O. Rappelet, Felton Galliano, Earl Angelle, Daize Cheramie, Jessie Guidry, Minor Cheramie, Dudley Bernard and James Summersgill III.

There was absent: Dr. J. A. Gravois.

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Hon. A. O. Rappelet, president, who announced the purpose of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the commission was ready for the transaction of business.

The President read several communications received, among these were House Concurrent Resolution # 182; Lafourche Parish Police Jury resolution dated June 8, 1970, and Plaisance Dragline & Dredging Co., Inc. letter dated June 10, 1970; all of said communications dealing with the purchase, removal and installation of the old Leeville bridge.

It was suggested by the President that in order to raise monies in order to take advantage of offers from the Lafourche Parish Police Jury and from the Louisiana Department of Highways, that the Port Commission issue certificates of indebtedness. Mr. Robert Mellon, bonding attorney with Nesom and Mellon, discussed the aspects of this type of indebtedness.

After considerable discussion amongst board members and with those others present, the president appointed James Summersgill III, Minor Cheramie and Earl Angelle to a committee to meet with Mr. T. M. Barker, president of the Lafourche Parish Police Jury, to discuss the present status of the purchase of the old Leeville bridge. Others present were invited to join in this committee meeting should they so desire.

It was moved by Daize Cheramie and duly passed that the meeting be adjourned.
