NOTICE TO BIDDERS: Sealed bids will be received by the Greater Lafourche Port Commission in the meeting room of the Tenth Ward Annex Building, Galliano, Louisiana, until 4:30 P.M. August 9, 1971, for the construction of Phase "B" - Boat Launch Facilities-Port Fourchon - Items to include, Shell Ramps, 1 Concrete Ranp, One Weather Shelter, 275' Bulkhead, 4,000 Cu. Yds. Clam Shells, 160'22" x 13" Pipe Arch and 310' Wharfs, Sealed proposals shall be marked "Phase B - Boat Launch - Port Fourchon".
