
Director Falgout then called for any other bids. There being none, he proceeded to open the bids and read as follows:

Upon motion by Murphy Cheramie, seconded by Robert Champagne and unanimously passed, the Board of Commissioners does hereby accept the low bid by Barriere Construction Company in the amount of \$548,840.00 in connection with the project entitled "ASPHALTIC OVERLAY AND IMPROVEMENTS TO PORT FOURCHON INDUSTRIAL PARK".
