## OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION FEBRUARY 26, 1991

The Board of Commissioners of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission met in special session in the Conference Room of the Commission Administration Building in Galliano, Louisiana, on Tuesday, February 26, 1991, at 7:00 PM pursuant to the provision of due notice in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner provided by law.

President Doucet called the meeting to order and requested that Board Member Cheramie call the roll:

President Doucet announced the purpose of the meeting, to discuss the Trip Seafood, Inc. lease.

Board Member Duet moved that the Board go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing possible litigation in connection with Trip Seafood, Inc. It was seconded by Roland and unanimously approved. The Board went into Executive Session at 7:02 PM.

At 7:55 PM the Board returned from Executive Session. There being no further business, upon motion by Roland J. Guidry, seconded by Robert M. Champagne and unanimously passed, the meeting adjourned.
