ORDINANCE	HO.	4

An ordinance levying and imposing taxes on all the property subject to taxation in the port area of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana for the year 1963.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of its Port Area:

SECTION 1. That acting under the authority of a special election held in the port area of the Greater Lafeurene Port Commission of the State of Louisiana (commission of the entire tenth ward of the Parish of Lafeurene, State of Louisiana, as the boundaries and limits of said ward existed on the date of the creation of said Commission), on April 8, 1961, a special tax of five (5) mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property in said port area be and the same is hereby levied, assessed and imposed on all of said property for the year 1963, for the needs and lawful purposes of said Commission.

SECTION 2. That the proper administrative officers of the Parish of Lafourche, Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to spread said tax, as hereinabove set forth, upon the Assessment Roll of said Parish for the year 1963 and to make the collection of the tax imposed for end on behalf of said Commission seconding to law, and that the tax herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all the property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and the collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be published in "The Lafourche Comet", a newspaper published in the City of Thibodaux, Louisiana, in the manner provided by law.

This ordinance having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Commission, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as fallows:
