

The following ordinance was presented by Jesse Sunday who moved its adoption, and was seconded by Felton Galliano.

ORDINANCE NO. 13

An ordinance fixing the date for assumption of official office of newly elected Commissioners of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission.

Be it ordained by the Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana acting as the governing authority of its Port Area:

Section 1. That newly elected Board of Commissioners of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, elected in the recent General Election of November 3, 1970, shall assume their official office on the first Monday of January, 1971 or January 4, 1971, the same date for Congressional assumption of office.

This ordinance having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Commission, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
