OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION JUNE 12, 1961

A special meeting of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission was held, pursuant to written notice given to all members, at the domicile of the Commission on June 12, 1961, at 3:00 o'clock P. M. The meeting was called by the President, A. O. Rappelet, who presided.

The roll was called and the following members were present:

President Rappelet gave a special report concerning the amended law introduced in the last session of the Legislature and successfully passed, and gave a summary of the provisions thereof.

President Rappelet then gave a special report concerning a meeting with the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers on June 9, 1961, at New Orleans, La. Present at the meeting were representatives of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, The Lafourche Basin Levee Board, Louisiana Department of Public Works.

After discussion and upon motion of Leo J. Theriot and seconded by Mayor John Egle, and unanimously passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Greater Lafourche Port Commission favor the realignment of the proposed Lafourche Jump Waterway project as proposed by the United States Corps of Engineers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Greater Lafourche Port Commission does hereby assume the responsibility of furnishing the rights of way to the Federal Government in its projects from Leeville to Golden Meadow and from Golden Meadow to the Gulf of Mexico, and from Leeville to Grand Isle, all as part of the Lafourche Jump Waterway, all without cost to the Federal Government.

There being no further business, upon motion of Leo J. Theriot,

seconded by John Egle, and unanimously approved, the meeting was adjourned.
