

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION

FEBRUARY 11, 1965

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in special meeting at its regular meeting place, the office of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, Galliano, Louisiana, on Thursday, February 11, 1965, at 10:00 A.M. pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner required by law,

There were present: A. O. Rappelet, Felton Galliano, Earl Angelle, Dr. J. A. Gravois, Minor Cheramie, Daize Cheramie and Jessie Guidry

There were absent: Euzebe Chouest and Dudley Bernard.

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Hon. A. O. Rappelet, President, who announced the purpose of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the commission was ready for the transaction of business.

On motion duly made by Dr. J. A. Gravois, seconded by Daize Cheramie and unanimously carried, it was moved that the board dispense with the reading of the minutes of the meeting of January 29, 1965.

The President then submitted a progress report on the following:

Funds will be available for jetties. Also reported that depth of channel between jetties was holding up.

Road to Fourchon is filled and shaped up and will be ready for shells within two weeks.


Flood protection levee is now under construction along Bayou Lafourche,

Reported on the progress of obtaining additional Caillouet right-of-ways.

The next subject discussed was regarding the attorney's fees for securing right-of-ways for the Jump Water Project. At that point on motion duly made by Dr. J. A. Gravois, seconded by Jessie Guidry and all others and unanimously carried, it was moved that the attorney's fee of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for the Jump Water Project be paid.

There being no further business to come before the board, upon motion by Jessie Guidry, seconded by Daize Cheramie and unanimously carried the meeting was adjourned.
