The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Hon. A. O. Rappelet, President, who announced the purpose of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the commission was ready for the transaction of business.

It was moved, seconded and duly passed that the Board dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting.

The President then received bids for Project No. 147-100, Hurricane Protection Improvements at Belle Pass, The only bid received was from Bartucci Bros., New Orleans, Louisiana, and it was opened. The lump sum; bid being \$667,500.00. The Engineer stated that this was well above the estimate of cost and suggested that the bid be taken under advisement and results of tabulations be reported to the board members.

It was moved by Jessie Guidry, seconded by Euzebe Chouest, and unanimously carried that the bid for Project No. 147-100, Hurricane Protection Improvements at Belle Pass be taken under advisement, and that the Engineer analyse the bid; and further that the President be and he is hereby authorized to negotiate with the bidder and take action after a special meeting is called for that purpose.

The President discussed the proceedings with the Lafourche Parish Water District # 1. There has been a suggestion of a joint meeting on Monday or Tuesday, August 1 or 2, 1966. This was indefinite.

It was then moved by Daize Cheramie, seconded by Earl Angelle and duly passed that the meeting be adjourned.
