

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION

AUGUST 27, 1969

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in regular session at its regular meeting place, the office of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, Galliano, Louisiana, on Wednesday, August 27, 1969, at 11:00 A.M., pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner required by law.

There were present: A. O. Rappelet, Felton Galliano, Earl Angelle, Daize Cheramie, Jessie Guidry, Minor Cheramie, Dudley Bernard and James Summersgill III.

There was absent: Dr. J. A. Gravois.

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission was duly convened by Hon. A. O. Rappelet, president, who announced the purpose of the meeting in accordance with the aforesaid written notice thereof, and then stated that the Commission was ready for the transaction of business.

It was moved by Dudley Bernard, seconded by Jessie Guidry and duly passed that the board dispense with the reading of the minutes of the meeting of July 21, 1969.

The President read the financial statements for the month of July, 1969, for both the General Fund and the APW-La-137G Construction Account.

Tennessee Gas and Transmission Corp. has appealed the decision of our recent suit concerning lowering the pipe lines in the port area. The Port Authority attorney, Stanley Perry, has filed his brief. No date has been set for the hearing.

The president recognized the representatives from the Louisiana State Department of Commerce and Industry, Mr. William Hackett, Mr. Shehane, and Mr. Cumiskey, and proceeded to explain the present construction and installation status of Port Fourchon facilities. Adjournment was made for on the sight inspection.

It was moved by Daize Cheramie, seconded by Jessie Guidry and duly passed that the meeting adjourned.
