MAY 14, 1973

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in regular session at the Nolty J. Theriot Building in Galliano, Louisiana on Monday, May 14, 1973, at 4:00 P.M., pursuant to the provisions of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof and duly posted in the manner provided by law.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, our engineers have reported that readings taken at Belle Pass show insufficient depth to accomodate navigation in the area, and

WHEREAS, the commercial interest have expressed fear of collision and it is apparant that the health and safety of our commercial fleet requires emergency measures be taken to dredge the pass,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Greater Lafourche Port Commission does hereby declare that an emergency exist in so far as the dredging of Belle Pass is concerned and that a sufficient sum of money be allocated on an emergency basis for the purpose of clearing the pass.

GREATER LAFOURCHE PORT COMMISSION

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That application for reimbursement and assistance be made with the Office of Emergency Prepardeness (O.E.P.) due to the fact that the silting of Belle Pass can be directly attributed to the recent prevailing high tides in the general vicinity.

It was moved by Tomey Doucet, seconded by Adam Gisclair, Jr., and unanimously adopted as follows:

RESOLVED: That acting on the recommendation of our attorney, we hereby authorize the disbursement of the sum of \$10,000.00 cash in full satisfaction of the judgement rendered against the Greater Lafourche Port Commission in the sum of \$15,013.44 together with interest of 7% thereon from December 11, 1970, in that suit entitled "Nesom, Mellon, Cavanaugh & Due VS Greater Lafourche Port Commission" Suit No. 28915, Division A, 17th Judicial District Court, Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana.

The following resolution was introduced by Anson Toups, seconded by Antoint Estay and duly passed.

RESOLVED: That the President and/or General Manager is hereby authorized by and on behalf of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission to make application to the State of Louisiana, Property Control Division for a new automobile, and to sign any and all papers necessary to complete this acquisition.

It was moved by Adam Gisclair, seconded by Harrison Cheramie, Jr., and duly passed that the meeting be adjourned.
