RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On July 25, 2973, the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration has notified the Greater Lafourche Port Commission that its application for federal disaster assistance has been approved in the sum of \$8,500.00, and

WHEREAS, a deadline of October 1, 1973, has been set for the completion of the work qualifying for federal assistance making it impossible to timely advertise for bids and complete the necessary work in the time alloted, causing the Port Commission to lose the disaster grant aid, and

WHEREAS, the work in question is of an emergency nature and unless it is completed promptly there is added risk of greater damage which may result from the normal high tides this time of year as well as possible damage during the hurricane season,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Greater Lafourche Port Commission does hereby declare that an emergency exist making it necessary to commence as soon as possible repair operations on the projects qualifying for federal disaster assistance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Greater Lafourche Port Commission General Manager, Irvin Melancon, Jr., be and he is hereby authorized to make the necessary arrangements with a reputable construction firm for the timely completion of these projects.

It was moved by Anson Toups, seconded by Harrison Cheramie, Jr., and unanimously passed that the meeting be adjourned.
