RESOLTUION

WHEREAS, without immediate assistance or relief, the Shrimping Industry which has been a traditional way of life for countless generations of South Louisianans is endangered, and

WHEREAS, other industries, such as the Oyster Industry, Agriculture, etc., recieve governmental assistance whenever economically threatened.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Greater Lafourche Port Commission fully supports the Gulf Coast Shrimpers and Boat Owners in their endeavor for immediate financial assistance from state and/or federal levels. This Commission also encourages the passage of whatever legislative measures concerning foreign imports, that the Shrimpers and Boat Owners feel is necessary to help them overcome their present circumstances.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be sent to the local news media, as well as to the U. S. Merchant Marine and Fisheries Commission, our state and federal representatives and members of the newly formed Shrimpers and Boat Owners Commission.

It was resolved by Irvin Melancon, Jr., seconded by Antoine Estay, and duly passed that the meeting be adjourned.
