FEBRUARY 13, 1978

The Greater Lafourche Port Commission of the State of Louisiana met in regular session in the Conference Room of the Commission Administration Building in Galliano, Louisiana, on Monday, February 13, 1978, at 3:00 P.M., pursuant to the provision of due notice given in writing to each and every member thereof, and duly posted in the manner provided by law.

It was moved by Ted Martin, seconded by Reed Danos, and duly passed that the "Construction Estimate No. 2" as submitted by Picciola & Associates, Inc., be accepted by the Board of Commissioners and that payment in the amount of \$9,112.50 be made to the contractor Boh Brothers Construction Company, Inc. as full payment, less 10% retainage, for work completed on "Relocation of Fourchon Road" as of February 10, 1978. The Board further instructed the Recording Secretary to file necessary claim with the Louisiana Department of Public Works for reimbursement of payments in accordance with Public Work's letter of acceptance and authorization dated May 6, 1977.

On motion by Reed Danos, second by Norman Doucet, the Board unanimously agreed to invite the Fourchon Land Owners (Louisiana Land & Exploration Co., City of New Orleans, and Caillouet Land Company) to the Commission's next meeting scheduled for March 13, 1978, in order to further discuss proposed leasing of their property by the Commission.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED: That a check in the amount of \$94,590.00 be sent to the First National Bank of Commerce, for the purpose of servicing our bonds, Series A, Series B, and Series C.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the National Bank of Commerce be, and they are hereby authorized to purchase for the Bond Sinking Fund, which they maintain for the Greater Lafourche Port Commission, as much as possible of the \$81,876.25, (which amount is due April 1, 1978), of American Treasury Bills maturing March 31, 1978; and as much as possible of the \$12,713.75, (which amount is due October 1, 1978), of American Treasury Bills maturing September 30, 1978.

It was moved by Ted Martin, seconded by Roland Guidry, and unanimously passed that the Recording Secretary be directed to contact Dos Gris Seafood and inform them that the Commission wishes to re-negotiate the exsiting lease between Dos Gris Seafood and the Greater Lafourche Port Commission for facilities located within the Fourch Commercial Marina.

It was moved by Norman Doucet, seconded by Reed Danos, and duly passed that the meeting be adjourned.
