The Board of Commissioners of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission met in special session on Monday, September 26, 2022 at 10:55AM at the Administration Office 16829 East Main Street, Cut Off, LA 70345.

President Cheramie called the meeting to order and Secretary M. Callais called roll.

ATTENDED: Harris Cheramie, Jr., Jimmy Lafont, Rodney Gisclair Sr., John Melancon Jr., Mike Callais, and Kris Callais

ABSENT: Johnny Ordonne, Curtis Pierce, and Larry Griffin

President Cheramie opened the floor for any public comment, being none, he presented for the board's consideration to approve the Corps of Engineers Right of Entry for Belle Pass Jetty Repair. Upon motion by Melancon second by K. Callais, with no public comment, the board unanimously approved the right of entry.

President Cheramie opened the floor for nominations to fill the vacancy of Seat E. Melancon nominated Ted Savoie. With no other nominations, a roll call ballot vote resulted in 6 votes for Ted Savoie and 3 absent.

Upon motion by M. Callais second by K.
