As of 1300, September 12th, 2024, the Captain of the Port (COTP) Houma has set the above Port Conditions.

Mariners are advised that post-storm debris remains throughout all parts of the COTP Zone, such as trees and other vegetation. Mariners should remain particularly vigilant and exercise caution while transiting, as aids to navigation may be missing or not watching in their current positions. The COTP requests mariners report hazards to navigation to VTS Berwick Bay or the MSU Houma Officer of the Day.

The COTP Houma will continue to monitor waterway conditions and ensure any new developments or changes are promptly provided to the maritime community through Marine Safety Information Bulletins and Broadcast Notice to Mariners.
