TO: Vessel Operators and Users of Port Fourchon Waterways

RE: Harbor Police Vessel Escorts

Port Fourchon Harbor Police will provide vessel escorts based on the following criteria:

- 1. An assist vessel (Tug) is required for barges and ships not properly equipped to safely maneuver through port waterways unassisted.
- 2. There must be a radio operator on the bridge who **speaks the English language fluently**.
- 3. Only vessels with size and/or draft restrictions will be considered for escort.
- 4. A **12-hour notice** is required before any escort is scheduled.
- 5. The vessel escort must take place during daylight hours only.
- 6. Vessels moored directly to the bulkhead **Will Not** be cleared unless it's necessary and does not interfere with the operation of the facility.
- 7. Any vessels not moored directly to the facility or corner moored vessels may be moved as needed.

Harbor Police Marine Patrol will make final decisions on all vessel escort requests.
