## **MOORING DOLPHINS PROCEDURES:**

Flotation Canal mooring dolphins are grouped into sets of three (3) dolphins and are 75' apart with 150' of space between the sets.

- The dolphins are available free of charge on a "first come, first serve" basis for short term docking of manned, motorized vessels. There are no Right of First Refusals on mooring dolphins unless approved by the board.
- 2. For any use, daily rental, or long-term lease, there is a minimum of 3 dolphins in Flotation Canal.
- 3. Dolphins are available for rent at a rate of \$75.00 per day per dolphin for unmanned or non-motorized vessels or vessels requesting a preferential berth (paying vessels will have first preference).

>Daily rent of \$225 for 3 dolphins in Flotation Canal.

- For long-term lease of 6 months or longer, the rate is \$50.00 per day per dolphin.
  These lease agreements are approved by the Board.
  >Please contact the Administration Office for long-term lease at (985)632-6701
- 5. Vessels must be moored channel side only. No mooring to the sides or back of dolphins.
- 6. All vessels along dolphins must be moored at 2 points.
- Flotation Canal allowed to have a maximum of 3 vessels wide; <u>not to exceed 150 ft</u>. <u>outward from the dolphins</u>. The maximum number of vessels per set of 3 dolphins is 6.
- 8. Caution should be used when mooring to dolphins. You are responsible for any damages.
- 9. Must adhere to Port Ordinance No. 71: "An ordinance prohibiting unattended vessels moored in the Port area when hurricane force winds are expected in the Port area within twenty-four (24) hours."
- 10.Place Company Logo sign or sticker on long-term leased dolphins.
- 11.At termination of daily or long term lease, Harbor Police need to inspect the dolphins for any damage and submit to administration a report with company information, photos, and a description of damage.
